When we look back at the incidents which took place just before Christ's crucifixion we are forced to think that the conduct of his disciples must have intensified His suffering. In the upper room He called them friends but in a time of crisis they did not seem to merit this title. While our Lord was enduring great spiritual agony in Gethsemane, Peter, James and John, his inner circle, fell asleep instead of supporting Him in prayer. About the same time another disciple, Judas Iscariot, was making arrangements to deliver the Savior to His enemies. When the soldiers came to arrest Jesus, His followers fled in fear. A few hours later as Jesus was being subjected to grievous indignities in the courtroom of Caiaphas, Peter denied ever knowing Him, not once but three times. It really upsets most of us when we think how his so-called friends treated Him just when He needed them most. But I wonder if we, who profess to love Him today, aren't guilty of doing the same thing in just a little different way as we dabble in sin instead of following His steps. I believe He is grieved when we stay away from the assembly of the church, which He established for our fellowship and growth. I am convinced He is hurt deeply when He sees us bite and devour one another and display an unkind spirit toward our fellow believers before a lost world. When you think about it the cross was probably a small part of His suffering. "Could you not watch me for one hour?" Matthew 26:40 garden of God.
