Don't forget we will be moving our clocks forward next weekend!



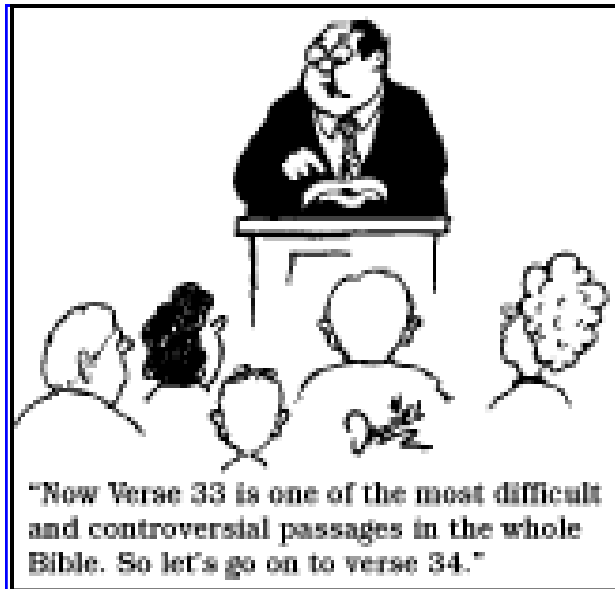
